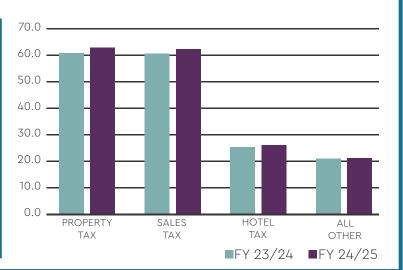

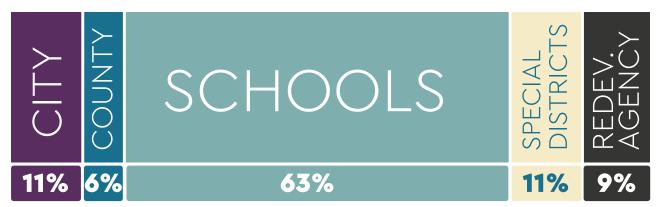

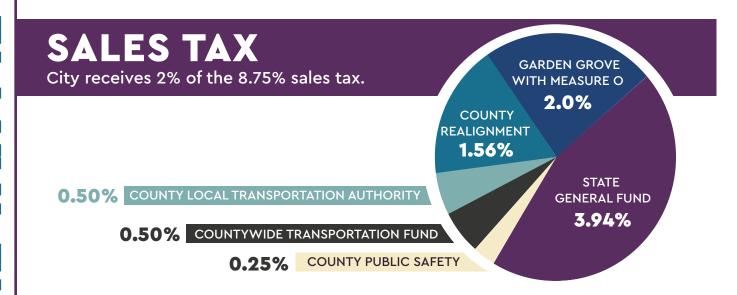
THE BIG.
