- Heat must be provided. All furnaces and heating sources must be functional.
- All visible mold growth must be appropriately and professionally abated.
- All electrical must be functional and safe.
 - All lighting and outlets must be functional.
- Smoke Detectors must be installed in each sleeping room and in every floor level.
- Carbon Monoxide Detectors must be installed on every floor level where there is fuel burning appliances.
- All rental homes and units must be free of pest and vermin.
- All plumbing must functional.
 - No leaks.
 - No clogged sinks or showers.
- No broken windows.
 - · All windows must have appropriate weather sealing.
 - · Window screens must be provided.
- Interiors must be maintained.
 - No chipped and peeling paint.
 - No damaged flooring.
