Exciting Enhancements Coming to Woodbury Park!

As part of the City of Garden Grove's commitment to enhancing community parks and recreational spaces, Woodbury Park is set to undergo a significant transformation. The \$11 million Woodbury Park Revitalization and Expansion Project will offer enhancements and brand new amenities for all ages to enjoy. The project is funded by the California Department of Parks and Recreation's Statewide Park Development and Community Revitalization Program, which supports underserved communities across the state.

New Park Offerings

- Expanded park space from 3.3 to 3.8 acres
- Two playground areas
- Recreational swimming pool
- Skate spot
- Basketball courts
- Walking trail
- Outdoor fitness equipment
- Picnic shelters
- Modern restrooms
- Parking lot

Project Timeline

Construction is anticipated to begin in mid-July, and the approximately 10-month project is expected to be completed in spring 2026.

A Groundbreaking Ceremony will be held on Tuesday, July 1 at 5:00 p.m.

Construction Schedule and Impacts

Work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. During the first and last hour of each workday, quieter activities will be prioritized in an effort to minimize noise.

Construction activities include tree removal, grading, underground utility work, and more.

Residents are asked to follow temporary “No Parking” signs and expect heightened traffic and noise due to construction activities. Access to residences, businesses, and schools will be maintained at all times.
