4-a. Pedestrian Closure on Janette Lane at Chapman Avenue

MATTERS FROM COMMISSIONERS

Commissioner Arbgast thanked the construction crew working on a City project at Chapman and Buaro for a job well done.

Commissioner Dalton inquired about the traffic signal at Chapman north of Nutwood Street. The signal does not cycle at a reasonable rate according to a resident he spoke to.

MATTERS FROM STAFF

Staff commented on the Bike Way Collaborative, which is a joint project with a majority of the agencies in the first and second districts. There have been ongoing meetings regarding this project and four corridors have been identified, which will connect major activity areas such as employment centers, transit stations, colleges, and universities. The Bikeways Strategy will also provide an implementation toolbox of bikeway treatments and enhancements, as well as information on bikeways funding resources. One of the better areas in Garden Grove, which has been identified, is the P.E. right-of-way. Staff will be riding along with OCTA to identify these areas and giving feedback. There is a lot of thought going into this plan and project.
