## West Parking Lot Enforcement: Karissa Yniquez-Parking Enforcement

Parking lot has been repaved and cleaned up and credit was given to Raul Leyva for working so diligently to keep everything clean.

Staff is making sure parking is sustainable and reviewing and cleaning up parking ordinances; staff has been working with the City Attorney. Signage will have to be reposted once the ordinances get approved at Council and then it will be enforceable.

An issue that comes up is the residents that live on Main Street would have to abide by the same rules of no overnight parking as it would seem selective and not be equitable to all off-site parking lots. Do mixed use developments fall under the same laws for overnight parking? Staff will continue to work on this issue and have conversations with the City attorney.

Continue to report any problems that you may see regarding parking by using the nonemergency number.

## Landscaping RFP Review

Only one viable candidate was received and proposed \$3080.00 per month. Trash removal (6) days per week and monthly maintenance of planters. A (1) time flat fee of \$7000 is required to revitalize planters with a selection of plant matter. Currently Main Street pays \$1620.00 per month this would nearly double the monthly payment. There is some money in Capital Improvements Projects for reserve. Staff has extended the current agreement (6) months to allow commission time to determine the next steps.
