DISCUSSION ITEMS

Infrastructure Update-Paul Guerrero:

- Vinyl wraps should be installed in approximately 3 weeks
- Way Finding signs – poles are erected and blades will be installed next day
- Parkletts- 3rd revised bid is within the budget-Agreement will be executed next week as there is a 30 day period to keep the price locked in. The lead time for the panels and planters is 2 months out, making installation about July. Planters go in first and then the panels are attached to those. No Parking signs will be posted 72 hours in advance of the work. It will be complete in approximately 3 weeks from start of construction.

MATTERS FROM COMMISSIONERS

Landscapers don't appear to be watering the hanging plants. Staff has contacted the landscaper and they are replacing the plants. They are to be watering three times per week. It might be time to consider replacing all plants with drought tolerant plant. Staff will research options for plants/flowers and then whichever gets the most votes will be put in. (succulents vs geraniums)

Trash/Warf restaurant has had an issue regarding rodent infestation. Too much trash is being left behind the restaurant. What can be done to get this problem addressed? Discussion was made as to getting a bin specific for the Warf restaurant. Elizabeth Dang will speak to the owner of the Warf about going to planning and inquiring about a new enclosure.

Concrete parking bumpers are crumbling and falling apart, some have rebar sticking out. They would like to have them painted with reflective paint. Staff will speak with Public Works about the bumpers.
