DISCUSSION ITEMS

Paul Guerrero Main Street update: All 35 tree wells have electrical receptacles. Timers will be placed later in the year. The receptacles will get a protective covering of some sort to keep them from getting broken. All saw-cut areas received power washing and dry vacuum. Power washing is scheduled for December 5, 2022. Panels will be delivered by end of November. Planters are there already. Installation should begin the week after Thanksgiving. The installation will be starting at Aum Beer traveling south toward Louie's and then north ending with Azteca. Each merchant is responsible for their own maintenance and upkeep for 3 years. The City will then have the option to renew.

Staff will look into cost of a new trash enclosure and bin prior to rehabbing the west parking lot.

Upkeep of landscaping-hanging plants are flowering. Some plants that are dead will be replaced.

New trash receptacles on Main Street – will be delivered on Monday November 14th- 55 gallon to the Public Works yard.
