Matters from Commissioners:

Commissioner Cepeda inquired about the dedicated left-turn signal at the intersection of Lampson Avenue and Euclid Street. Staff shared that a new traffic signal project is opening for bids this month. This project includes modifications for the intersections of Lampson/Euclid and Lampson/Western. Commissioner Sander expressed concerns regarding the start of construction coinciding with the Strawberry Festival. Staff noted that construction will likely occur after the festival.

Commissioner Blackmun raised concerns regarding speeding vehicles at the intersection of Chapman Avenue and Knott Avenue. Commissioner Sanders advised that speeding is a law enforcement matter and recommended forwarding these concerns to the Garden Grove Police Department's Traffic Division.

Commissioner Sanders reported that the Reverend at St. Olaf Church (9th St. and Lampson Ave.) expressed concern regarding vehicles parking on the east side of 9th Street. The parked vehicles block the view of drivers exiting the parking lot on Sundays. Staff will conduct a line of site analysis to address these safety concerns.

Commissioner Zhou reminded the staff that the California Highway Safety Improvement Program grant cycle occurs every two years in even years, opens in March. He also noted that if the city wishes to apply for the Federal Safe Streets and Roads for All grant program is currently open.
