REQUEST: Lot Line Adjustment approval to remove an existing lot line between two parcels, with Assessor's Parcel Nos. 100-383-24 and 100-383-29, thereby consolidating the two (2) lots into a single lot, Parcel 1. The combined lot size of the new Parcel 1 will be 10,850 square feet. The site is in the R-1 (Single-Family Residential) zone. The project is exempt pursuant to CEQA Section 15305(a) – Minor Alterations in Land Use Limitations.
