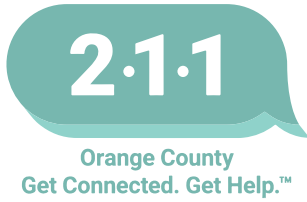


RESOURCES FOR Individuals experiencing HOMELESSNESS or are at Risk of Homelessness
