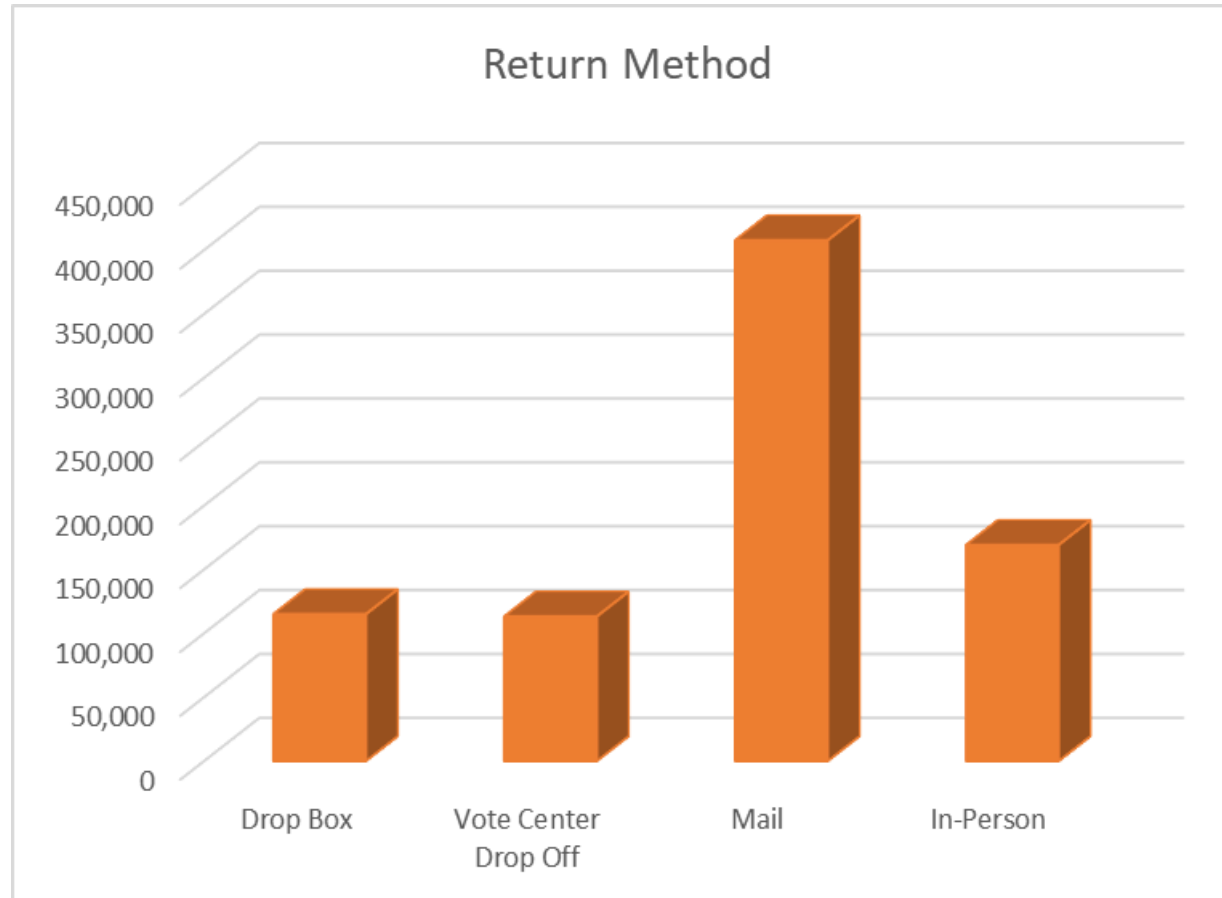


March 3, 2020 Primary Election

- 50.1% turnout
- Highest presidential primary election turnout since 2000
 - 82% voted by mail
 - 18% voted in-person, mostly on Election Day
- Less than 10,000 CVR/provisional ballots vs. 140,000+ provisional ballots in 2018 General Election

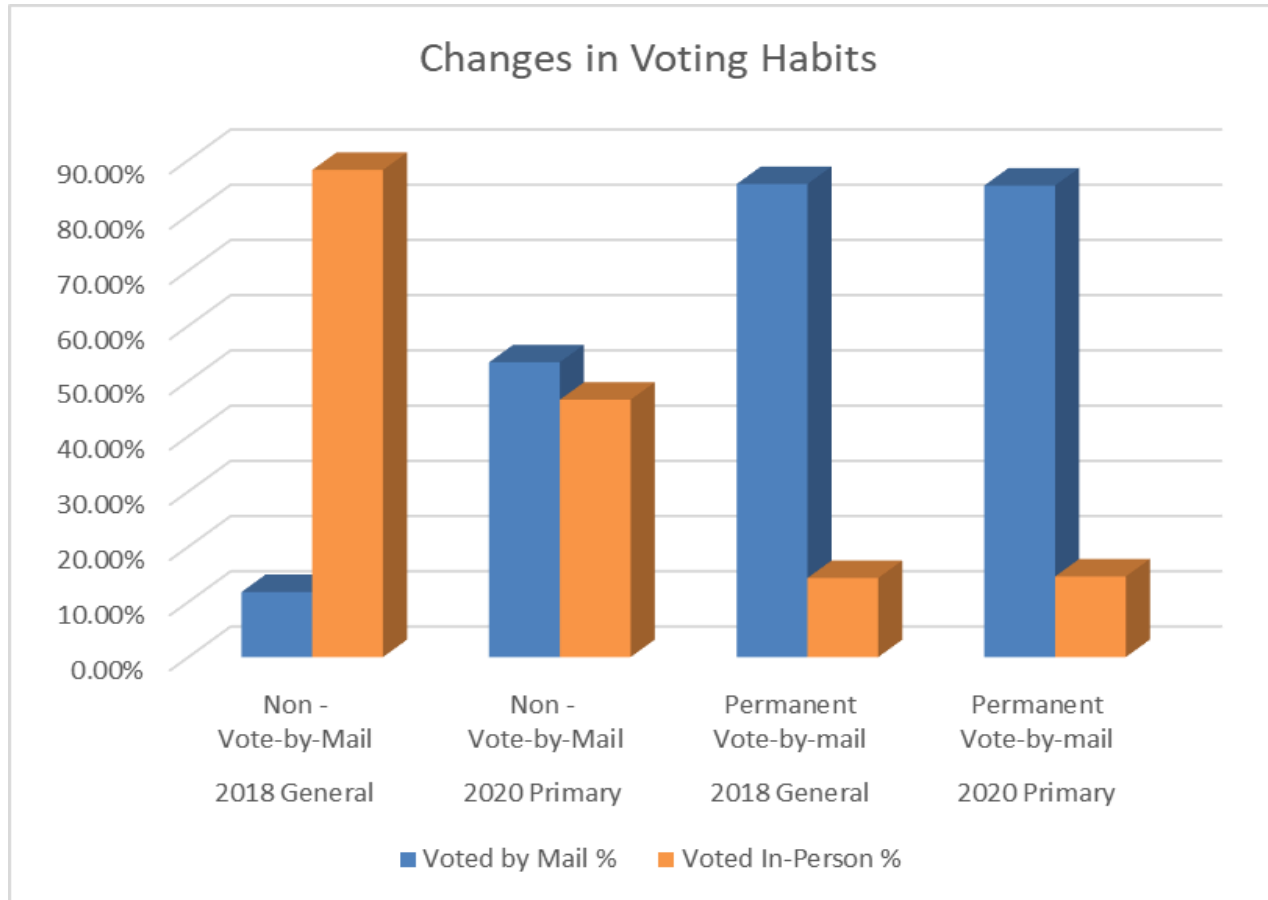

November 3, 2020 General Election

- Changes to voting and elections due to COVID-19
- 167-170 Vote Centers; all will operate 5 days
- 116 ballot drop boxes



How is Voting Changing?



All registered voters will receive a vote-by-mail ballot with a prepaid postage return envelope



Choices such as mailing ballot, voting in-person, and dropping ballot off at any Vote Center and ballot drop box throughout Orange County



Hired, professional staff at Vote Centers






Vote Center Services

- Register, update address or change your party
- Vote in-person or drop off your ballot
- Get a replacement ballot
- Receive language assistance
- Use accessible ballot marking device



Vote Center Security

-  Electronic check-in with real-time updates
-  Controlled chain of custody and tamper seals
-  Same data encryption as law enforcement

Health & Safety at Vote Centers



To ensure health and safety, the following has been developed for Vote Centers to include:

- Larger space requirements
- New site layout to maintain physical distancing
- Cleaning supplies
- Frequent, regular cleaning and disinfecting
- Daily cleaning checklist

Voter's Choice Act Criteria

- Proximity to public transportation.
- Proximity to communities with historically low vote by mail usage.
- Proximity to population centers.
- Proximity to language minority communities.
- Proximity to voters with disabilities.
- Proximity to communities with low rates of household vehicle ownership.
- Proximity to low-income communities.
- Proximity to communities of eligible voters who are not registered to vote and may need access to same day voter registration.
- Proximity to geographically isolated populations, including Native American reservations.
- Access to accessible and free parking.
- The distance and time a voter must travel by car or public transportation.
- Traffic patterns

Recruitment and Selection

- Extensive public input
 - 42 public meetings
 - 1,000+ suggestions
- Mapping Tool
- Site assessment and accessibility requirements
- Availability

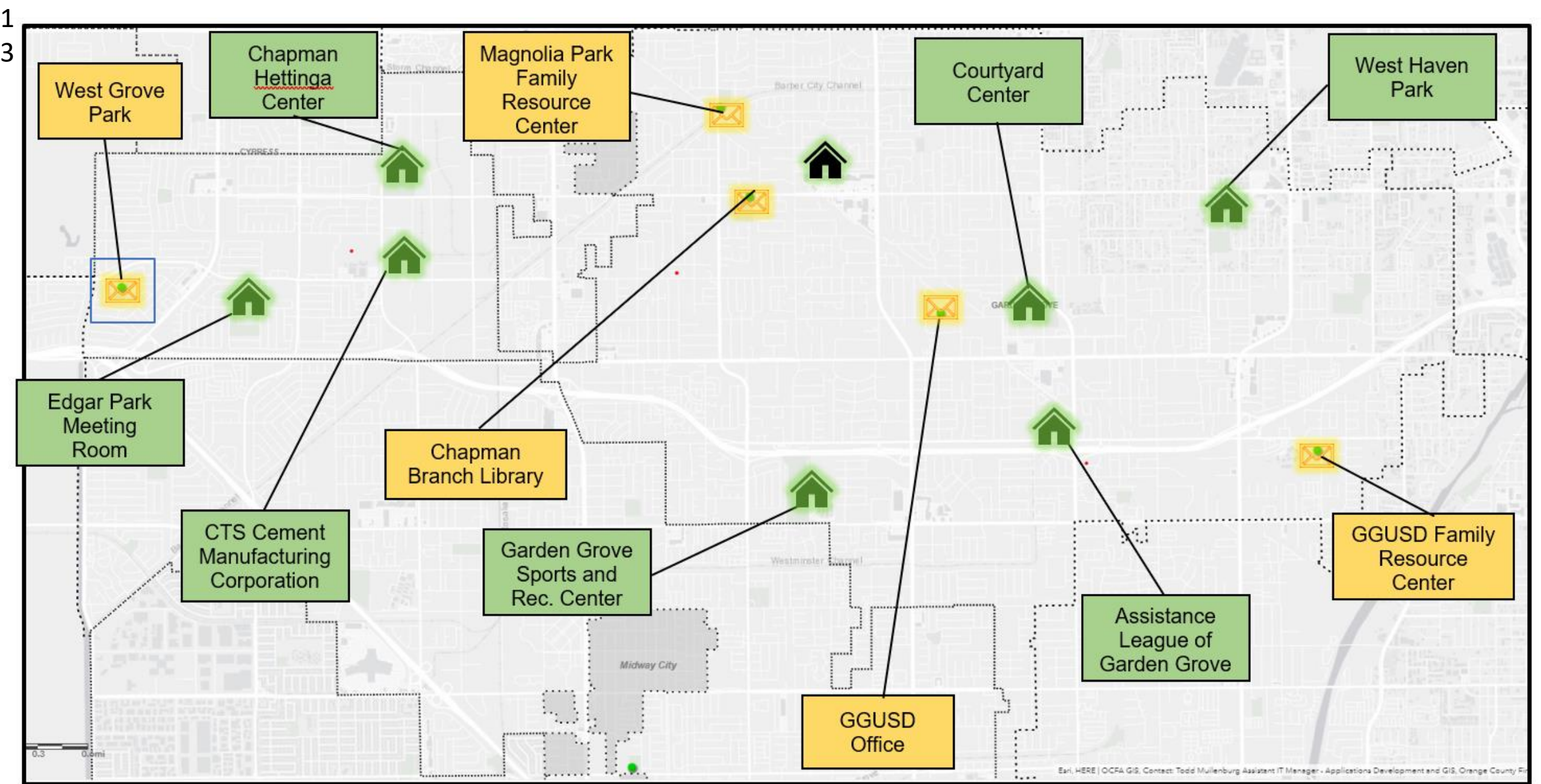

- Vote-by-Mail mailing begins
- Ballot Drop Boxes are open

Monday, October 19, 2020

- Voter registration deadline

Tuesday, October 20, 2020

- Same-day voter registration begins

Friday, October 30, 2020

- All Vote Centers are open 8am to 8pm

Tuesday, November 3, 2020 Election Day!

- All Vote Centers are open 7am to 8pm
- Ballot Drop Boxes close at 8pm
- Vote-by-mail ballots must be postmarked by this date



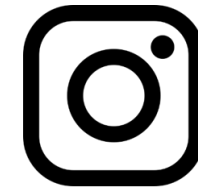

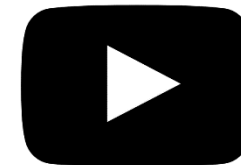
