establish development standards for the regulation of duplexes and triplexes. The proposed Amendment is intended to establish uniform development standards that will include new setbacks, new building height and building separations, with emphasis on appropriate architectural building design and massing, as well as

new parking and driveway design.

APPLICANT: DAVID MARTIN

LOCATION: EAST SIDE OF WESTERN AVENUE, NORTH OF SANTA

RITA CIRCLE AT 11852 WESTERN AVENUE

REQUEST: To amend Title 9 of the Garden Grove Municipal Code to

allow motorcycle sales in the M-1 (Limited Industrial) zone with the approval of a Conditional Use Permit, in conjunction with a request for Conditional Use Permit approval to allow motorcycle sales at 11852 Western Avenue. The site is in the M-1 (Limited Industrial) zone.

ACTION: Other than the applicant, no one spoke in favor of or in

opposition to the request. Resolution Nos. 5633 (A) and 5637 (CUP) were approved by six ayes, with one amendment to the Conditions of Approval, with Commissioner Brietigam absent. LOCATION: WEST SIDE OF BOWEN STREET, NORTH OF TRASK

AVENUE AT 13431 BOWEN STREET

REQUEST: To remodel and expand two units of an existing duplex.

Unit 'A' will be expanded from a 742 square foot, two-bedroom, one-bathroom unit to a 2,269 square foot, four-bedroom, three-bathroom unit. Unit 'B' will be expanded from a 933 square foot, two-bedroom, one-bathroom unit to a 2,185 square foot, four-bedroom, three-bathroom unit. The site is in the R-2 (Limited

Multiple Residential) zone.
