C.1. GENERAL PLAN UPDATE

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT

APPLICANT: CITY OF GARDEN GROVE

LOCATION: CITYWIDE

REQUEST:

The Planning Commission shall consider the General Plan 2030 Update and the accompanying Environmental Impact Report for recommendation to the City Council for Certification of the EIR and adoption of the General Plan 2030 Update. The General Plan Update is a comprehensive update of the City's 1995 General Plan. General Plan 2030 includes an update and reorganization of existing elements, resulting in the following State mandated and optional elements: Land Use Element: Community Design Element; Economic Development Element; Circulation Element; Infrastructure Element; Noise Element; Air Quality Element; Parks Recreation and Open Space Element; Conservation Element; Safety Element, and Housing Element. This is the second in a series of public hearings on the General Plan 2030 Update and accompanying Environmental Impact Report.

At this meeting, the public has the opportunity to provide oral testimony and written correspondence. The Planning Commission shall take into consideration all matters concerning the General Plan Update and accompanying Environmental Impact Report and forward their recommendation onto the City Council.

Recommend that City Council certify the Environmental Impact Report for the General Plan Update 2030 and adopt the General Plan Update 2030 that encompasses the entire City.

ACTION:

Seven people spoke in favor of the request and no one spoke in opposition to the request. Resolution No. 5641, recommending that City Council certify the Environmental Impact Report for the General Plan Update 2030 and adopt the General Plan Update 2030 that encompasses the entire City, with an amendment to Chapter 2 – Land Use Element, Policy-LU-4.9 and LU-IMP-4C, along with a map change, was approved by four ayes with Commissioners Beard, Kirkham, and Nguyen absent. No further action unless appealed by August 7, 2008. City Council action is required on the EIR and General Plan Update 2030. The recommended date is August 12, 2008.
