REQUEST: Site Plan approval to construct a 2,598 square foot

addition to an existing 3,800 square foot restaurant, Capital Seafood Restaurant; Variance approval to

deviate from the required front setback and

landscaping; Conditional Use Permit approval to allow

the restaurant to continue to operate with an

Alcoholic Beverage Control Type "41" (On-Sale Beer and Wine, Eating Place) License. The site is in the

C.2. CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. CUP-169-05

APPLICANT: THUAN PHAM

LOCATION: NORTHEAST CORNER OF HARBOR BOULEVARD AND

TRASK AVENUE AT 13458 HARBOR BOULEVARD.

REQUEST: Conditional Use Permit approval to change the type of

an existing Alcoholic Beverage Control License from a Type "20" (Off-Sale Beer and Wine) to a Type "21" (Off-Sale General) for an existing mini-market, Dee's Mini-Market. The site is in the C-1 (Neighborhood

Commercial) zone.

ACTION: Commissioner Chi arrived at the time of this item and

included himself in the discussion. Other than the applicant/owner and the applicant's representative, one person spoke in favor of the request and no one spoke in opposition to the request. The applicant wrote a letter in favor of the request and one Police Department memo was written in opposition to the request. Resolution No. 5507 was approved by four ayes with Commissioners Margolin and Lecong, and Vice Chair Jones voting no. A numerical correction to Page 2 of the Resolution shall read: The crime count for the District is 339. No further action unless

appealed by September 22, 2005.

D. <u>MATTERS FROM COMMISSIONERS</u>

Chair Jones announced September 14th, 2005 as the grand opening date for the new medical facility for the Boy's and Girl's Club of Garden Grove.
