#### **Approval of Minutes April 15, 2009:**

#### **Items for Discussion:**

##### **A. 2009 REFUSE SERVICE RATE CPI ADJUSTMENT**

Letter was mailed to each resident regarding CPI adjustment and online payments for faster processing of the payments. There is usually a longer time delay for in-house processing. No staff jobs will be cut because of this. This will have no effect on county fees.

##### **B. Prescription Drug/Pharmaceutical Disposal**

Do not throw prescription drugs or pharmaceuticals down the drains-instead crush/and or dispose of them in tightly closed containers or mix with used coffee grounds. Some drugstores will take them on a voluntary basis.

##### **C. Sanitary Sewer System Maintenance Update**

Brent Hayes gave a synopsis of City Projects under construction. There have been some storm drain complaints but everything is running fine. It was noted that Garden

Grove is very flat but everything is functioning properly at this time.
