**SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY (SOCALGAS®) NOTICE OF REQUEST TO INCREASE RATES FOR ANGELES LINK PHASE 2 ACTIVITIES APPLICATION NO. A.24-12-011**

**WHY AM I RECEIVING THIS NOTICE?**

On December 20, 2024, Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas), filed the Angeles Link Phase 2 application (A.24-12-011) with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to increase revenue to recover forecasted costs associated with Phase 2 of Angeles Link. SoCalGas is requesting \$89.5 million, \$118.3 million, and \$65.5 million for the years 2026, 2027, and 2028, respectively. The total forecasted costs are \$273.3 million.

If the CPUC approves this application, SoCalGas will recover forecasted costs in gas rates over a 3-year period beginning after approval of the application. This will impact your monthly bill.

**WHY IS SOCALGAS REQUESTING THIS RATE INCREASE?**

Angeles Link is envisioned as a pipeline system dedicated to public use for the transport of clean renewable hydrogen. In Phase 2, SoCalGas will identify a preferred route, conduct refined design, engineering, and environmental studies, and continue stakeholder engagement activities for the Angeles Link project. The final objective of the proposed project is to develop a system that will transport clean renewable hydrogen from regional third-party production and storage sites to end users in Central and Southern California, including the LA Basin (inclusive of the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach). Developing a clean, renewable hydrogen transportation system is crucial for establishing a hydrogen economy in California and helping the state achieve its environmental goals. The application covers costs associated with planning and refining the project.

**HOW COULD THIS AFFECT MY MONTHLY GAS BILL?**

If SoCalGas' rate request is approved by the CPUC the average rates shown below for 2026, 2027 and 2028 would go into effect. These estimates do not take into account any other SoCalGas requests that may be submitted (and/or approved) during the same period.

This application will be assigned to a CPUC Administrative Law Judge who will consider proposals and evidence presented during the formal hearing process. The Administrative Law Judge will issue a proposed decision that may adopt SoCalGas' application, modify it, or deny it. Any CPUC Commissioner may sponsor an alternate decision with a different outcome. The proposed decision, and any alternate decisions, will be discussed and voted upon by the CPUC Commissioners at a public CPUC Voting Meeting.

Southern California Edison Company (SCE) hereby submits this Tier 1 Advice Letter to the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission or CPUC) that provides the requested information in Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision (D.) 21-10-020.

**PURPOSE**

This Advice Letter provides information required by Ordering Paragraph (OP) 1 of D. 21-10-020 regarding SCE's restoration, rebuilding, and reconstruction activities related to the Mountain Fire. The Governor declared a State of Emergency for the Mountain Fire on November 7, 2024 and issued an Executive Order on November 8, 2024. The Mountain Fire was fully contained on November 27, 2024.

**BACKGROUND**

Ordering Paragraph 1 of D. 21-10-020 requires an electric Investor Owned Utility (IOU) to file a Tier 1 Advice Letter if (1) the Governor of California or the President of the United States issues a disaster declaration, and (2) there is damage to IOU's facility or a service outage. Ordering Paragraph 1 states:

"In the event of a disaster, declared either by the Governor of California or the President of the United States, that also damages their facilities or leads to a service outage, Investor-Owned Utilities (IOUs) shall file a Tier 1 Advice Letter within 15 business days from when they are allowed into a disaster area to assess the damage to their facilities.<sup>1</sup> IOUs shall file this Advice Letter with the Commission's Energy Division, with a copy

sent to the Communications Division at [TD\\_PAL@cpuc.ca.gov](mailto:TD_PAL@cpuc.ca.gov). The Advice Letter also must be provided to the appropriate local government contained within the disaster area, including the chief executive or leader of the city, township or Tribal government. In the case of an unincorporated area, the communication must be established with the appropriate County. In the case of Tribal governments, the Advice Letter must be provided to any Tribe(s) that have Tribal lands or ancestral territory overlapping with any portion of the disaster area.

The Advice Letter shall include the following details:

- a. a report of what facilities or equipment was damaged;
- b. restoration and/or rebuild plans, including a description of what is being repaired, replaced or added, and maps of where the restoration will occur;
- c. the date the investor-owned utility received access to the damaged area;
- d. the timeline to make repairs;
- e. any changes to any energy/communication infrastructure required; and
- f. the contact information of the individual responsible for community engagement in these instances.”

Below, SCE provides the requested information for the disaster declarations covered in this advice letter.

### **Mountain Fire**

The Mountain Fire occurred in SCE service territory commencing on or about November 6, 2024 and was fully contained on November 27, 2024. On or about November 7, 2024 Governor Newsom issued a State of Emergency Proclamation for Ventura County which is located in SCE service territory. SCE began restoration activities on November 7, 2024. As of the date of the disaster declaration, restoration activities are still ongoing.

**B. Restoration or rebuild plans**

SCE began the service restoration as soon as it was safe to conduct the work. Service restoration was accomplished by replacing equipment on a like-for-like basis. Some restoration efforts are still ongoing at the time of this Advice Letter.

**C. Date received access to damaged areas**

SCE was not under restricted access to the affected areas and began doing damage assessments on November 7, 2024. However, access to affected areas were limited by the rugged terrain. The Mountain Fire was fully contained on November 27, 2024.

**D. Timeline to make repairs**

SCE completed service restoration for approximately 3,500 customers, from November 7, 2024 to November 25, 2024. Minimal restoration efforts are still ongoing at the time of this Advice Letter.

**E. Changes to infrastructure**

Service restoration was accomplished by replacing equipment on a like-for-like basis. Equipment was brought up to the latest construction standards.

**F. Contact information or community engagement**

This was a service restoration activity accomplished by replacement of equipment on a like-for-like basis, not a rebuild effort. Because this was a service restoration effort requiring immediate action, SCE did not engage with community stakeholders prior to the restoration work as contemplated by OP 2 of D. 21-10-020 prior to commencing the work. Accordingly, SCE will not be submitting a second Advice Letter as contemplated in OP 3.

**PROPOSED TARIFF CHANGES**

This submittal does not require any tariff revisions and would not increase any current rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.

**TIER DESIGNATION**

Pursuant to OP 1 of D. 21-10-202, this Advice Letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

Pursuant to General Order (GP) 96-B, Rule 5.1, SCE requests that this Tier 1 Advice Letter become effective on May 11, 2022, the same date as submitted.

**NOTICE**

**Why am I receiving this notice?**

On December 20, 2024, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) filed an application (A.24-12-010) with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) requesting approval to sell SCE's Irwindale Business Center property (the Property) in Irwindale, California (the IBC Application). The IBC Application seeks approval of a revenue increase of approximately \$3.46 million, which, after taxes, will equate to a recovery of approximately \$2.49 million. While there will be a temporary increase in rates, this transaction will ultimately save SCE's customers approximately \$2.1 million per year due to decreased property-related charges and costs.

If the CPUC approves SCE's request, it will affect your rates and bill.

**Why is SCE requesting this rate increase?**

- SCE is seeking to sell the Property because SCE no longer needs the Property's office space for its operations.
- Although the sale will result in a one-time (after-tax) loss of approximately \$2.49 million and a temporary \$0.01/month raise in rates, the sale will eliminate the future property taxes and long-term operations, investment and maintenance costs for the Property. The estimated future customer savings is approximately \$2.1 million per year.

**How could this affect my monthly electric rates?**

If SCE's rate request is approved by the CPUC, the average residential monthly bill using 500 kWh per month would increase by approximately \$0.01 or less than 0.1% per month in the year following the close of the sale.

The Administrative Law Judge will issue a proposed decision that may adopt, modify, or deny SCE's application. Any CPUC Commissioner may sponsor an

alternate decision with a different outcome. The proposed decision, and any alternate decisions, will be discussed and voted upon by the CPUC Commissioners at a public CPUC Voting Meeting.

**CITY HOSTS FREE BULKY ITEM DROP-OFF SITES  
BEGINNING JANUARY 18**

The City of Garden Grove and Garden Grove Sanitary District, in collaboration with Republic Services, will host a series of community cleanup days, offering residents the opportunity to dispose of bulky items for free. The first of six events will take place on Saturday, January 18, 2025, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., at Pacifica High School, located at 6851 Lampson Avenue. The event will also include household battery recycling and paper shredding services.

Residents may bring unwanted bulky items, such as non-refrigerant appliances, furniture, mattresses, and carpets. Electronic waste, including printers, computers, and televisions, and green waste, such as leaves and lawn clippings are also accepted. This will be a self-service event in which residents will be unloading their own items, on a first-come, first-served basis, until bins are full.

Residents may recycle household batteries, such as AA, AAA, D, C, and old power tool batteries. Automotive batteries will not be accepted. Paper shredding services will be available on a first come, first served basis to help safely dispose of personal documents. There is a limit of four boxes per vehicle.

## Cal Cities-sponsored bond agency issues over \$59 million in affordable housing bonds

The California Statewide Communities Development Authority (CSCDA) issued \$59,450,000 in tax-exempt bonds to benefit Moldaw Residences, a multilevel continuing care retirement community in Palo Alto.

Moldaw Residences operates 170 independent living apartments and 23 assisted living and memory care units. The community offers a full continuum of care, including licensed assisted living, memory care, hospice services, and partnerships with skilled nursing facilities. These services ensure residents can remain at Moldaw throughout the end of their lives.

CSCDA worked with Palo Alto and others to provide the refinanced housing bonds.

## New federal homeless data underscores the need for ‘sustained’ funding

**California managed to blunt a continued increase in homelessness, but much more work (and funding) is needed**

A recent [federal report](#) found that although California’s homeless population remains larger than any other state, efforts to address the crisis are showing promising results. The number of homeless Californians increased by just over 3% in 2024 — a much lower rate than the nation overall and 40 other states. California is also leading the nation in the availability of year-round shelter beds. California’s year-round shelter bed capacity grew by 5.7% to over 200,000 beds.

Homelessness nationwide increased by 18%, with a record 771,480 people experiencing homelessness. The federal findings are part of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development’s annual point-in-time count, a rough estimate of the number of people experiencing homelessness in a single night in January.

Nearly every population — particularly families with children — experienced an increase in homelessness. The only group to experience a decline were veterans, which the report notes is due to “targeted and sustained funding.”

For years, Cal Cities has called on state leaders to provide [ongoing funding](#) to address homelessness and increase the supply of affordable housing. This has helped secure one-time funding several years in a row. Cal Cities also supported [Proposition 1](#) (2024), which included \$6 billion for an estimated 11,150 new treatment beds and housing units.

California still has a long way to go, with more than 180,000 people experiencing homelessness in the state. A survey of [205 cities](#) last year found that many cities are worried about their ability to reduce homelessness long-term without sustained state investment. The federal data underscores that now is not the time to cut critical homelessness funding. Securing new investments to address homelessness and increase affordable housing is again one of [Cal Cities’ top priorities this year](#).

The findings arrived just before Gov. Gavin Newsom [previewed the 2025-26 State Budget](#). Noting that the “word of the year” would be accountability, he previewed a new website that will track local governments' compliance with state housing and homelessness policies using publicly available data. The website is expected to launch by the end of the week. Cal Cities will share more information about this resource and the budget on Friday.



## California adopts major reforms to address home insurance crisis

### Cal Cities will continue to advocate on this issue in the coming year

The past two months have seen the largest reforms to California’s home insurance marketplace in almost 40 years. These developments cement the final pieces of Insurance Commissioner Ricardo Lara’s [efforts](#) to improve the function and coverage of the insurance marketplace. Cal Cities actively engaged the Department of Insurance on the proposals and provided testimony during the rulemaking process. Cal Cities has also partnered with other local government organizations to respond to any future regulatory and legislative developments.

Improving fire prevention, preparation, and access to insurance policies are all [major legislative priorities](#) for Cal Cities in 2025.

#### What changed?

As of Jan. 2, insurers can use catastrophe modeling when writing policies. Catastrophe models use past data from catastrophic events to predict losses from future disasters on a multiyear basis. Insurance companies can use these computer models to analyze risks from potential future disasters when deciding how much capital is needed to cover claims.

California historically has prohibited the use of catastrophe modeling. Instead, insurers had to use disaster data from the previous 20 years to write insurance policies and justify rate increases. Proponents argue this change will allow for more accurate pricing of rate increases.

The regulations require catastrophe models to use the best scientific information on risk mitigation at the property, community, and landscape levels. While this provision is a good start, Cal Cities will continue to advocate for stronger language that ensures rates recognize local wildfire mitigation efforts and that property owners can get coverage if they have completed specific mitigation measures.

In exchange for these models, insurance companies must cover at least 85% of “wildfire distressed” areas. The state defines wildfire distressed zones as ZIP codes that overlap with high and very high wildfire severity zones in which 15% or more of the dwellings are on the state’s [FAIR Plan](#).

The rules also require insurance companies to maintain a Wildfire Risk Portfolio Register of every insured property, the date the property was added to the portfolio, and the total number of exposures insured under each property, as well as the start and termination date of the policy if applicable. This should provide more transparency to consumers if insurance companies cancel their policies.

### What’s next?

On Dec. 30, the Department of Insurance submitted the final piece of its Sustainable Insurance Strategy, the [Net Cost of Reinsurance in Ratemaking Regulations](#), for review.

Insurance companies can buy reinsurance from other companies to help cover themselves from being entirely responsible for massive losses during disasters. California is one of a few states that does not allow insurance companies to include the cost of reinsurance in their rates.

Under the proposed regulations, insurers could include reinsurance in their rate packages. However, they would need to increase coverage in wildfire-prone regions by writing policies for at least 85% of their share of the statewide market. This final piece comes as the Legislature reconvenes with the insurance crisis as one of its top priorities.

Lawmakers have already introduced a few related bills. [AB 1](#) by Asm. Damon Connolly would require the Department of Insurance to regularly consider whether to update its ratemaking regulations to include additional building hardening measures for certain wildfire mitigation efforts. Cal Cities supports the measure and will work with the author’s office to pass it. A measure by Asm. Lisa Calderon, [AB 75](#), would require insurers to provide advance notice to residents about the use of unmanned aircraft to take images of their insured property and make such images available to the policyholder upon request. Cal Cities has not taken a position on [AB 75](#), but in general supports legislation that bolsters fire prevention efforts and encourages insurance companies to consider those efforts when writing or renewing policies.
