#### **OBJECTIVE**

To provide a summary of the AI Marketing Workshop, co-hosted by the City of Garden Grove and the Orange County Inland Empire Small Business Development Center (OCIE SBDC), to inform local businesses on the benefits of AI-powered marketing tools and strategies to drive revenue growth.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Artificial Intelligence continues to reshape how small businesses approach digital marketing, customer service, and lead generation. This workshop was part of an ongoing series of technology-focused business seminars co-hosted by the City and the OCIE SBDC. The goal of the series is to help local businesses explore practical AI tools that drive innovation, digital growth, and long-term competitiveness. To further support local businesses, the City has also integrated AI-based tools into its own economic development efforts. These include Placer AI, which provides insights on consumer and visitor traffic patterns, and Size Up, a platform that offers competitive benchmarking and market research data. Together, these tools help identify growth opportunities, guide data-informed decision-making, and strengthen business outreach across Garden Grove.

#### DISCUSSION

On July 31, 2025, the Economic Development and Housing Department partnered with the OCIE SBDC to co-host the Transforming Marketing Strategies into Revenue Growth with Artificial Intelligence workshop at the Garden Grove Community Meeting Center. The purpose of the workshop was to support local businesses in adopting AI-powered tools to enhance customer engagement, strengthen digital outreach efforts, and increase online visibility.

The event included multiple interactive sessions covering topics such as:

- Automated customer support through AI
- AI-driven social media and lead generation
- Voice search optimization and omnichannel SEO strategies
- Hidden analytics tools for more sales

• Fast AI-powered website development

Attendees were provided with hands-on demonstrations and real-world examples showcasing how these tools can increase operational efficiency and generate measurable revenue growth. The workshop drew in approximately 100 registered participants, including local business owners, entrepreneurs, and marketing professionals. Participants left with practical strategies and were encouraged to explore additional consulting opportunities available through the Small Business Development Center network.

#### **CONCLUSION**

The City continues to support local businesses through innovation, education, and technology adoptions. By cultivating a stronger, data-driven business community, the City provides valuable tools such as Placer AI and Size Up, which offer insights to help businesses grow and stay competitive.

Cal Cities has <u>released a primer</u> on what the legislative authors are calling the most ambitious changes to the state's environmental protection law. Signed by Gov. Gavin Newsom as part of the <u>2025 budget package</u>, <u>AB 130 (Wicks)</u> and <u>SB 131 (Wiener)</u> took effect immediately on June 30. So, how big are these changes? And how could they impact your city?

What do these new laws do?

AB 130 created a new exemption to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for specific housing developments that meet site and project criteria, targeting existing urban areas. The bill also made changes to tribal consultation processes, hazardous substances assessments, air quality standards, and project labor requirements.

SB 131 changed the scope of the administrative record for litigation and the ability to focus environmental analyses on single conditions for what would otherwise be exempted housing projects. Under the new law, a variety of projects now qualify for CEQA exemptions, including:

- Rezoning actions that implement an approved housing element
- Farmworker housing
- Drinking water and onsite sewage treatment projects benefiting disadvantaged communities
- Broadband deployment in a right-of-way
- Public parks or non-motorized recreational trail facilities
- Wildfire risk reduction activities
- Daycare centers and rural health clinics
- Nonprofit food bank or food pantry projects
- Advanced manufacturing facilities
- High-speed rail and passenger rail stations

How could these changes impact my city?

Cities are encouraged to <u>use the primer</u> to identify and review the statute. Next, determine how these laws might impact projects in their community. The details really do come down to the specifics.

# Governor signs solicitation and trafficking bill into law

Gov. Gavin Newsom today signed a bill backed by Cal Cities that will make it easier for law enforcement to address prostitution and human trafficking.

The measure, <u>AB 379 (Schultz)</u>, became the <u>center of controversy</u> earlier this year over whether people who solicit 16- and 17-year-olds for prostitution should face increased punishments. Ultimately, lawmakers reached a compromise and amended the measure to add additional protections and enforcement. The bill passed through the rest of the legislative process with strong bipartisan support.

#### How it works

AB 379 (Schultz) creates a new offense for loitering with the intent to purchase commercial sex, increases penalties for purchasing commercial sex from minors, and requires certain businesses to display information on human trafficking. Cal Cities has asked for similar changes since the enactment of SB 357 (Wiener, 2022), which repealed the state's anti-loitering law. Since the repeal, many cities have reported increased levels of prostitution.

Specifically, AB 379 makes it a misdemeanor for any person to loiter in any public place with the intent to purchase commercial sex. The bill increases punishment for those who solicit 16- and 17-year-olds for prostitution, regardless of trafficking status, if the buyer is more than three years older than the victim.

AB 379 also increases fines for businesses that facilitate prostitution and human trafficking, creates a new fund for victim support services, and tasks the Office of Emergency Services to allocate funds to district attorney offices to target human trafficking rings.
